
Community Benefit Report

New vision and mission

We envision healthy people and communities throughout Alabama and advance our mission to champion healthy adolescent development through evidence-informed sexual health education and services.

Training



We held 13 professional development workshops and curricula trainings across Alabama, training 200+ people, which resulted in reaching approx. 60,000 youth and families.

Resources



We provided resources to 3,000 people through our trainings, workshops, advocacy and outreach events, and supporter communication.

Advocacy



We met with legislators at the Alabama State House during the legislative session to emphasize the importance of medically accurate and inclusive sex education for all Alabama students.

Partnerships



We started the Alabama Sexual Health Coalition (ASHC) this year. The Coalition is committed to sexual health rights for all people, and has grown to nearly 20 organizations and individuals.

The Alabama Campaign is celebrating its 20th year in 2019. We started as a group of concerned community members focused on reducing the rate of teen pregnancy in Alabama. Over the years the teen pregnancy rate has declined, but young people still need access to sexual health education and services so they can make informed decisions about their bodies and their relationships.
