Sexual Assault

- Occurs on Continuum from Harassment to Violent Rape
- US High Rates of Sexual Assault
 - Between 20% and 25% of women
- Sexual assault prevalence related to male dominance and interpersonal violence, especially toward women

Consent is...

- Explicit
- Affirmative
- Ongoing
- Mutual
- Between Competent Individuals

Sexual Assault is...

NOT a result of misunderstanding

NEVER justified

NOT a result of uncontrollable desires

NOT usually committed by psychopathic strangers

Difficult to Report

NOT only a woman's issue

Learn How to Support Survivors

Interacting with a Survivor

- BELIEVE THEM!!!!
- Validate Emotions
- Avoid Showing Your Own Emotions
- Don't Coax Them into Action
- Provide support if Choose to Report
