Program Overview

IN·clued is a 3-hour community-based inclusive sex education curriculum for LGBTQ+ & allied youth. This curriculum addresses the existing gaps in education for LGBTQ+ individuals, equipping youth with resources to advocate for their healthcare needs.



- Lower teen pregnancy, HIV, and STI rates
- Provide inclusive sex education information
- Give youth the tools they need to advocate for their sexual health
- Educate health centers on how to provide LGBTQ+ inclusive sexual healthcare

Currently, IN-clued is the only evidence-based sexual health education program designed specifically to meet the needs of LGBTQ youth.



Impact

- Increase youth knowledge of sexual health
- Increase advocacy among youth for their health needs
- Youth go on to have a greater likelihood of receiving preventative services for sexual health
